



UIC-CEA AWARD

Semester / Summer

The UIC-CEA Award is a scholarship of up to \$3,000 toward the cost of a semester program at one of the following CEA Program Centers: Barcelona, Paris, Buenos Aires, Seville, and Prague; and a \$1,500 scholarship for summer study at any CEA location.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Good Academic Standing
- Pell grant recipients and underrepresented students are encouraged to apply.
- While abroad students must be registered for a minimum of 12 credit hours for a semester program. For this award eligibility, there is no minimum for summer programs.

APPLICATION CHECKLIST

Incomplete application packets will not be considered.

- Applicant Information Sheet (attached)
- Statement of goals, which should be no more than 1 typewritten page.
Your statement of goals should name the Study Abroad program and term in which you are participating, why you chose this particular program, and how this program will help in your short-term and long term personal, academic, and professional goals.
- SAO budget sheet for your program
- Your UIC Financial Aid award letter detailing the types and amounts of financial assistance you expect to receive (Loans, scholarships, grants, and personal funds).
- Copy of your Academic History (printed from UIC Web for Students)
