



UIC-DIS DIVERSITY FUND

Semester / Summer

Through generous support from the Danish Institute for Study Abroad [DIS], the UIC-DIS Fund was established to support traditionally under-represented UIC students in studying abroad. The award is up to \$1,000 for a DIS semester program and up to \$500 for a DIS Summer program.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

In addition to the established eligibility requirements to apply to Study Abroad, the applicant must have an active application to enroll in a DIS study abroad program

Preference will be given to applicants who are able to demonstrate financial need and/or those who can best demonstrate how their participation in the program will lead to greater diversity in study abroad programs. The goal of this funding initiative is to encourage a more diverse group of students to participate in study abroad programs. Many groups of individuals have had historically low rates of participation in study abroad, including those from underrepresented minority groups; first generation college attendees; recent immigrants; students with disabilities; those who identify as LGBTQ; students from low income backgrounds; and even students who study in particular fields, such as the sciences, IT, engineering, mathematics, health professions or other technical areas.

Define your own diversity and how your participation will add to the diversity of your selected study abroad program?
- Personal statement #2 to be no more than one typewritten page responding to:
How will this program help you in your short and long term personal, academic, and professional goals?
- Your SAO budget sheet that outlines the estimated costs of your program
- If applicable, a copy of your most recent Financial Aid Award Package Statement from UIC. This is available on the finances tab of *my.UIC/UIC Connect*
- A copy of your Academic History (printed from UIC Web for Students)

- Same as for SAO application for each term, i.e. mid-October and mid-March
